Day 1

Arrival to Cairo

Marvel at the [Great Sphinx](#), the ancient statue with the body of a lion and the face of a pharaoh, which has been guarding these pyramids for thousands of years. Here you also visit the Valley Temple - the setting for many rituals and mummifications—for stunning views of this incredible landscape, making it an unforgettable part of your Egypt honeymoon tour.

Day 3

Khan El Khalili Bazaar:

is a bazaar whose fame extends through Cairo's historic center. Founded as a trading center during the Mamluk period and named [Khan El Khalili Bazaar](#) after one of its several ancient caravanserais, the bazaar district has now become one of the major attractions in Cairo for tourists as well as for the Egyptians.

Day 4

Fly to Luxor

You will take an early morning Luxor tour, Egypt's outdoor museum. Upon arrival, you will be welcomed aboard an awesome Nile cruise, Salacia, where service, comfort, and cuisine all heightened the experience.

After lunch on board, the evening will see you visiting

Karnak Temple:

Wander through this vast complex dedicated to the god Amun-Ra. Marvel at [Karnak Temple's](#) Hypostyle Hall, a forest of 134 towering columns, and the sacred lake.

Luxor Temple:

Admire this stunning temple built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II, [Luxor Temple](#) featuring grand colonnades and the Avenue of Sphinxes.

Day 5

Explore west bank with Nile River cruise

Enjoy breakfast on board and wake up to a stunning sunrise over the Nile. You now depart for the [West Bank](#) of Luxor, which includes the

Valley of the Kings:

On the list of the world's most famous and then some archaeological sites, it is also an ancient royal cemetery for the New Kingdom pharaohs of Egypt, including that most well-known king, Tutankhamun. There are over sixty tombs within the [Valley of the Kings](#) and more are being made, all of which have various degrees of decoration and were carved deep into the rock with symbolic artwork, hieroglyphs, and secret chambers intended to assist these pharaohs in entering the afterlife.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

One of the most beautiful and well-preserved of ancient Egyptian temples. this astounding mortuary The [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#) was built for the purpose of honoring one of Egypt's few female pharaohs. The terraces, statues, and relief carvings of the temple mark the prosperity of her reign and her devotion to the god Amun. As you walk through the temple with your guide, you will be taught the story of Hatshepsut, how she came to power in a male-dominated world, and how her legacy still captivates historians and visitors alike. beautifully set against the dramatic cliffs of Deir el-Bahri. Also,

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, [the Colossi of Memnon](#) have watched over the gateway to the long-lost mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters (60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.

After your Egypt tour, you will be taken back to your hotel to rest.

Overnight on board the cruise in Edfu.

Day 6

Explore Temples of Edfu and Kom Ombo

After breakfast, take a horse-drawn carriage ride through the countryside to see Egypt's best-preserved

Edfu Temple:

Dedicated to the god Horus, is one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, [Temple of Edfu](#) containing a magnificent pylon and elaborate carvings.

Kom Ombo Temple:

Visit this temple, peculiarly dedicated to Horus and Sobek, the crocodile god. A [Kom Ombo Temple](#) is an essential experience during your Cairo and Nile cruise honeymoon.

Enjoy the old landscape of the Nile, and sail towards Aswan just as the day wanes.

Visit the Unfinished Obelisk and Philae Temple

Philae Temple:

Visit this beautiful [Philae Temple](#) dedicated to the goddess **Isis**, relocated to Agilkia Island.

Unfinished Obelisk:

See the largest known ancient obelisk, abandoned in its quarry the [Unfinished Obelisk](#)

you can go back to your floating hotel for a great dinner under Aswan's starry skies.

Travel to Sharm El Sheikh

Check out and board the flight to Sharm El Sheikh after your final breakfast by the Nile. Transfer to your hotel room, where you can chill and relax on the shores of the Red Sea.

Free day at Sharm El Sheikh

You can enjoy your day at your hotel or take an adventurous optional tour to Ras Mohammed National Park.
