After enjoying a delicious, wholesome breakfast at the hotel, your guide leads you to the Giza Plateau to start the journey by enjoying the sight of one of the Seven Wonders of the World:

the Great Pyramids of Giza:

Standing in testimony to the engineering and architectural talents of the ancient Egyptians, the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> have been a subject of fascination for millennia. Built as tombs for the kings of the Old Kingdom of Egypt, they represent the highest level of pyramid-building techniques.

the Great Sphinx:

Carved out of a fantastic limestone ridge, the Great Sphinx is one of Egypt's iconic and mystifying monuments. With a lion's body and a Pharaoh's head, it stands for strength, wisdom, and royal power, the Pharaoh represented being considered by some to be Khafre himself.

After your pyramid visit, lunch will be served at a traditional Egyptian restaurant. Then you will visit the New

Grand Egyptian Museum:

Located a few kilometers away from the Giza Pyramids, the Grand Egyptian Museum has been

designed to portray ancient Egypt in his immense grandeur never seen before. This colossal museum

abides by a broad collection of artifacts, including the renowned treasures of King Tutankhamun, in

presenting a comprehensive array of Egypt's long and intriguing history.

also known as the Giza Museum, which is an archaeological museum located in Giza, Egypt,

approximately 2 kilometers away from the Giza pyramid complex. Finally, you would be dropped back

at your hotel.

Day 3

Day 3: Fly to Luxor - Nile Cruise Round Trip

Get up early and check out of your hotel; you will be transferred to Cairo Airport. Once in Luxor, you will be met and assisted, then dropped off by a deluxe air-conditioned vehicle to discover on your Nile Cruise. Lunch will be served on board your cruise as it sails. Free time with afternoon tea on the cruise

ship. Dinner is served onboard.

Breakfast on board while sailing to Edfu in the morning, then a visit to Horus Temple in Edfu, the best-preserved cult temple in Egypt. Back to the Nile cruise boat to continue sailing to

The Temple of Kom Ombo is an unusual double temple in the town of Kom Ombo in Aswan Governorate.

Lunch on board with afternoon tea and Free time at leisure. Dinner on board while enjoying the Egyptian Galabya party.

Overnight aboard your cruise in Kom Ombo.

Visits: Horus Temple, Kom Ombo.

Day 5

Day 5: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Early sail to <u>Aswan</u> while enjoying your Breakfast on board. Then, you will be picked up to enjoy a day tour to the Granite Quarries and the

Temple of Philae:

Set on Agilkia Island in the proximity of Aswan, the Temple of Philae presents a splendid ancient edifice geared primarily toward the goddess Isis. A wonder to behold, with its exquisite hieroglyphics, grand columns, and serene island panorama, the owners of this temple would spill much history concerning Egypt's Ptolemaic and Roman eras.

Head back to your cruise, where Lunch will be served on board. End the night with a delicious dinner on board with a belly dance show and an Egyptian folkloric show.

Abu Simbel Temples:

The Great Temple of <u>Abu Simbel</u>, in Nubia near Egypt's southern border, is among the most awe-inspiring monuments of Egypt.

It takes about 3 hours driving from Aswan to Abu Simbel in a private air-conditioned vehicle. Arrive at Abu Simbel, see the impressive Temples of Ramses II at Abu Simbel, which are dedicated to the four universal gods Ptah, Re-Harakhte, Amun-Re, and Ramesses II. Then return to your Nile Cruise in Aswan. Free time at leisure, then have your dinner on board and enjoy a Nubian Show.

Overnight aboard your cruise in Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Visits: Aswan, Optional tour to Abu Simbel Temple.

Day 7

Day 7: Sail to Kom Ombo Temple - Sail to Esna

Sail to Kom Ombo while having your breakfast on board, then enjoy a guided visit to the Temple shared by two gods, Sobek and Haeroris, in Kom Ombo. Back to the Nile Cruise to set sail to Edfu with lunch on board. Continue sailing to Esna, with afternoon tea on board. Dinner on board in Esna.

Overnight aboard your cruise in Esna.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Visits: Kom Ombo Temple.

Day 8

Day 8: Luxor Nile Cruise Excursions

Sail to <u>Luxor</u> with breakfast on board your Nile Cruise, then head out to enjoy a guided tour to the West bank of the River Nile in Luxor to visit the Valley of the Kings, the Temple of Hatshepsut, the powerful Egyptian queen, and the

Colossi of Memnon:

On the west bank of the Nile near Luxor, the Colossi of Memnon are two gigantic stone statues that have stood guard there for more than 3,400 years. Each of these statues stands for Pharaoh Amenhotep III sitting on his throne, an ideal symbol of his earthly might and divinity.

back to the cruise with lunch, dinner on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Visits: Valley of the Kings, Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut, Colossi of Memnon.

Day 9

Day 9: Luxor Nile Cruise - Back to Cairo

Breakfast on board, then disembark your Nile cruise in Luxor and enjoy a guided tour to the <u>East Bank</u> of Luxor, visit the magnificent

Karnak Temple:

One of the largest and really amazing religious complexes in the world, Karnak temple in Luxor,

stands as a breathtaking testimony of ancient Egyptian religious fervor and architectural genius.

Luxor Temple:

Located in central Luxor, it is a sublime ancient edifice of worship; the shrine was primarily dedicated

to the god Amun. Unlike many other temples that were built mostly during later periods, the Luxor

Temple was constructed during the New Kingdom Period and served as a venue for the celebration of

the Opet Festival, associated with the divine wedding of the gods.

Lunch will be served in a good-quality restaurant in Luxor. Later on, you will be transferred to Luxor

Airport for your flight back to Cairo, where you will be met and assisted at the airport, then escorted to

your hotel near Cairo Airport.

Overnight in Cairo.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Visits: Karnak Temple, Luxor Temple.

Breakfast at the hotel with free time at your leisure, then you will be transferred to Cairo International
