Your Egypt tour continues in Luxor, where you should visit Karnak Temple together with Luxor Temple before boarding a Nile cruise. Aswan promises visitors a remarkable experience of viewing the High Dam, Philae Temple and the Unfinished Obelisk. While sailing to Edfu to see its temples alongside those in Kom Ombo, your family tour will take you to the West Bank, where you will find the ancient sites of the Valley of the Kings and Hatshepsut Temple. Egypt family tour package offers extraordinary experiences by showcasing ancient landmarks alongside modern sights while exploring history alongside local traditions and the beautiful natural scenery of Egypt.

**Itinerary** 

Day 1

**Arrival in Cairo** 

Egypt Day Trips representative will be waiting for you at Cairo Airport, holding a sign with your name for easy identification. You will be transported to the hotel by a private air-conditioned car.

Accommodation: hotel in Cairo (1 night)

Day 2

Tour to Giza Pyramids, Grand Egyptian Museum & Khan Al-Khalili

A day of historical exploration at Giza ancient sites begins immediately after your breakfast with a connection to your professional guide at your hotel. Your journey begins at the Giza Pyramids, where you will visit the major attractions, including the Great Pyramid of Khufu, together with the Pyramid of Khafre and the Pyramid of Menkaure. For centuries, the Great Sphinx, a statue with the face of a

pharaoh, has stood atop a lion's body to protect the pyramids.

After lunch, you continue your Cairo day tour by going to the Grand Egyptian Museum (GEM). The Museum, one of the biggest contemporary museums in the world that displays ancient Egyptian artifacts, is a must-see for tourists. It exhibits its extensive group of statues along with displaying

artifacts that combine with royal treasures through different dynastic periods.

Then, proceed in your Cairo walking tour to the Khan el Khalili traditional bazaar, where patrons can buy handcrafted jewelry and artwork, as well as spices for cooking and customary mementos. Step into the atmosphere that surrounds one of the oldest markets throughout the Middle East.

Lunch at a local restaurant is included.

Day 3

Fly to Luxor – Luxor East Bank tour

Eat breakfast before moving to Cairo Airport to board the flight that will take you to Luxor, which

stands as the largest outdoor historical complex on Earth. Visit Karnak Temple, where visitors can access the biggest religious complex throughout history, which reveres Amun-Ra. They can roam

through the Hypostyle Hall with 134 kolossi and explore both the sacred lake and the obelisks.

Then, head to Luxor Temple, which stands as a magnificent structure that Amenhotep III and Ramses

II constructed using grand colonnades alongside the Sphinxes Avenue.

Enjoy lunch services while relaxing on the Nile cruise.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 4

Luxor West Bank trip & Sail to Edfu Temple

You will go to the West Bank just after your lunch in one of the local restaurants in the area. You can see the tombs of pharaohs at the Valley of the Kings in the West Bank, where wall paintings preserved their decorations for centuries. Don't miss seeing the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which honors that amazing female Egyptian ruler by rising like a stunning masterpiece from the Deir el-Bahari cliffs. It features terraces with colonnades that overlook the vast desert landscape in Luxor. The final stop of your trip will be the Colossi of Memnon, which comprises two big statues that originally stood against

the mortuary temple of Amenhotep III.

At the end of your day, you will return to your cruise for lunch and sail to Edfu Temple. Enjoy

a Galabia Party onboard in the evening.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 5

Edfu & Kom Ombo Temples trip

Enjoy a time journey to Egypt's Greco-Roman period following your breakfast, and then proceed to Edfu Temple, which serves Horus as its patron deity and stands as one of Egypt's finest temples because of its impressive pylon and detailed carvings. The double Temple of Kom Ombo lets visitors examine its dedication to Horus and Sobek because they worshiped here.

Guests are taken from Sohag to Aswan for a memorable dinner cruise experience in the evening.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 6

**Aswan City Tour** 

Breakfast is complete, then you join a flight from Cairo Airport to Aswan. You will arrive at the Aswan High Dam immediately after touching down since this dam stands as one of the world's most spectacular feats of human engineering. The High Dam provides irrigation water across most of Egypt and maintains Nile River water management. There you have the opportunity to observe the breathtaking views of Lake Nasser, which stands as the world's largest artificial water reservoir. Experience the largest known ancient obelisk at the Unfinished Obelisk in its original quarry space, where it remained because of splitting characteristics.

The Philae Temple was relocated to Agilkia Island following the construction of the High Dam. This temple's smooth reliefs depict ancient Egyptian myths and legends, creating a completely different world. You will enjoy your lunch at a local restaurant before checking into your Nile cruise for rest and enjoyment.

Check in at your Nile cruise before settling down for a period of rest.

Accommodation: Nile Cruise (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 7

**Disembarkation – Return to Cairo** 

After having breakfast, leave your cruise and transfer to Aswan Airport for a flight to Cairo to rest in your hotel.

Optional tour:

<u>Abu Simbel Temples</u>: Explore these gigantic temples built by Ramses II, dedicated to himself and his queen, Nefertari. Enjoy watching the magnificent statues and detailed carvings that capture the splendor of ancient Egypt.
