# **Itinerary**

Day 1

#### **Arrival in Cairo**

Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, our representative will greet you and accompany you to your air-conditioned vehicle to your hotel.

# Day 2

### Giza Pyramids & Egyptian Museum Tour + Flight to Luxor

The Egyptologist tour guide will show you the best Cairo attractions, including the Egyptian Museum, which combines modern architecture with ancient Egyptian artifacts. After eating your Egyptian lunch, you will continue to see the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, which are still considered to be among the wonders of the ancient world.

Learn more about the experts who have been maintaining the Great Pyramid's existence since the time of ancient civilizations by looking up at its structure. The <u>Great Sphinx</u> is the final destination of the day, which features a limestone statue that thus extends as one continuous stone mass.

You will be transferred to Giza Railway Station, which will transport you to an overnight train journey that leads to Aswan.

Accommodation: Overnight sleeper train (1 night)

Meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

# Day 3

#### **Arrival in Luxor + visit Karnak Temple**

You will immediately visit the <u>Karnak Temple</u> after your Luxor trip begins, as it remains the largest religious facility built with its focus on the god Amun. During your exploration, you will see the Hypostyle Hall along with its 134 enormous columns along with its obelisks while strolling around the sacred lake while watching its detailed religious and pharaonic art. After your visit, you can enjoy the remaining free time of your day to explore Luxor.

Day 4

### Visit the Valley of the Kings + transfer to Aswan

After breakfast, start the day with a journey across the Nile to the Valley of the Kings. Explore the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> to see Book of the Dead scenes and ancient writings in royal tombs of Tutankhamun Ramses II and Seti I. At the end of your Egypt trip, you'll be transferred to Aswan.

Day 5

## Arrival to Aswan + Free day or optional Abu Simbel tour

Enjoy your free day in Aswan with an optional tour to Abu Simbel.

Optional Tour:

Abu Simbel: It contains the great temples of Ramesses II and his wife, queen Nefertari. The temples are built into the mountain side and famous for their giant pharaonic statues.

Accommodation: in Hotel (1 night)

Day 6

Tour to Philae Temple & Nubian Village

After breakfast, take a water taxi to visit the <a href="Philae Temple">Philae Temple</a>. It was relocated to save it from the rising waters of lake Nasser. The temple was genuinely devoted to the goddess Isis and would provide a representative sense of the religion practiced by ancient Egypt, in addition to offering a breathtaking view of their magnificent columns and exquisite carvings. You can spend the afternoon relaxing before heading to <a href="Nubian Village">Nubian Village</a> in the evening to have dinner with a local family and experience their gracious hospitality.

# Day 7

#### Felucca ride & return to Cairo

Wake up early for your felucca sail along the Nile as the golden sun casts a glow on the Sahara. After breakfast onboard, enjoy some free time before an afternoon flight back to Cairo.

## Day 8

#### Final departure

Enjoy your day with breakfast at the hotel before leaving. The representative will drive you from your hotel to the airport, where you will depart while holding onto cherished memories of Egypt's historic sites together with its picturesque vistas and generous welcome.
