Day 3

Egyptian Civilization Museum, Cairo Citadel & Old Cairo

Your guide will arrive to take you on another beautiful day in Cairo, continuing your Egypt honeymoon tour.

Your journey will begin at the Museum of Egyptian Civilization. This museum is home to an unmatched collection of artifacts, statues, and interesting displays that showcase Egyptian art and history, from glorious royal mummies to exhibits that trace the living narrative of Egypt's civilization over thousands of years.

Saladin Citadel:

You will continue to the <u>Saladin Citadel</u>, a fortress erected in 1183 AD on the Mokattam Hills as a refuge of Cairo. Inside the Citadel,

Mosque of Muhammad Ali:

One of the most spectacular monuments in Cairo, the Mosque of Muhammad Ali was designed by Turkish architect Yusuf Bushnak for Egypt's ruler Muhammad Ali, who reigned for over 45 years. This stop adds a special touch to your Cairo honeymoon experience.

You will finally finish your Cairo walking tour in Old Cairo, visiting the historic churches of Abu Serga and the Hanging Church. In addition, you will visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue.

Transfer back to your hotel in Cairo at the end of the tour.

Day 4

Fly to Aswan - Aswan Day Tour - Nile Cruise

Valley of the Kings:

On the list of the world's most famous archaeological sites, the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> served as the ancient royal cemetery for New Kingdom pharaohs of Egypt, including the most well-known, Tutankhamun. With over sixty tombs—many richly decorated and carved deep into the rock with symbolic artwork, hieroglyphs, and secret chambers—this site was designed to guide pharaohs into the afterlife.

Temple of Queen Hatshepsut:

Beautifully set against the dramatic cliffs of Deir el-Bahri, the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u> is one of the most beautiful and well-preserved ancient Egyptian temples. This astounding mortuary temple was built to honor one of Egypt's few female pharaohs. Its terraces, statues, and relief carvings reflect the prosperity of her reign and her devotion to the god Amun. As you walk through the temple with your guide, you will hear the story of Hatshepsut—how she rose to power in a male-dominated world and how her legacy continues to captivate historians and visitors alike.

Colossi of Memnon:

For more than 3,000 years, the Colossi of Memnon have watched over the gateway to the long-lost mortuary temple of Amenhotep III on the west bank of the Nile near Luxor. Standing about 18 meters (60 feet) high, each statue is carved from a single block of sandstone.

After your Egypt tour, you will be taken back to your hotel to rest.

The largest temple complex in Egypt and a UNESCO World Heritage site, the Karnak Temple invites you to roam its massive precincts, admire the towering columns of the Hypostyle Hall, and observe inscriptions that tell the stories of the pharaohs' reigns.

Luxor Temple:

Then, head to the magnificent Luxor Temple, dedicated to the Theban Triad, with granite statues of Ramses II standing guard at the entrance. The temple's open courtyard and high obelisks make for stunning photographs, perfect for capturing memories of your romantic getaway in Egypt.

Afterwards, transfer to Luxor Airport for your flight to Sharm el-Sheik after completing your Luxor tour (via Cairo if direct flights are not available), where more relaxation and adventure await you on your honeymoon in Egypt.

- -Your Alexandria tour begins at the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, an elaborate burial site established around the beginning of the end century AD, maintaining a fascinating amalgam of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman cultural patterns. This ancient burial ground consists of spiral chambers, marvelous carvings, and tombs, giving evidence of the historical and cultural diversity of Alexandria.
- -Next, adjourn to Pompey's Pillar, an imposing Roman column erected in honor of Emperor Diocletian, and thereafter, explore the ruins of Serapeum, a temple devoted to the god Serapis.

Lunch in a quality local restaurant.

-Continue to the Qaitbay Citadel; the 15th-century citadel stands out for its magnificent architecture on the very site of the Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the ancient Seven Wonders of the World. Being reasonably well-preserved, the Citadel does afford great vantage points over the Mediterranean and gives some insights into the history of Alexandria as an important maritime city.

-End your day at the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a modern wonder manifest from the ancient Library of Alexandria. This cultural center holds millions of books, exhibitions, and manuscripts, symbolizing Alexandria's legacy of learning and scholarship; an inspiring stop in your honeymoon tour as you embrac Egypt's rich cultural heritage together.
