Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Welcome to Egypt! Custom-arranged airport pick-up service for international flights, in this case, centralized at Cairo Airport. An Egypt tour guide will be waiting for you, holding a sign with your name to help you identify them swiftly.

Afterwards, you will be escorted to your private air-conditioned Mercedes for a comfortable transfer to your hotel. What a wonderful start to one of the best Egypt short breaks.

Day 2

Giza Pyramids & Grand Egyptian Museum

After breakfast at your hotel, go on a day trip to continue your Egypt short breaks and discovery and wonderment at all of Giza's most famed historical places with your private expert guide.

Giza Pyramids & Sphinx:

Starting at the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> tour, the trek would take you to the famous Great Pyramid of Khufu, the Pyramid of Khafre, and the Pyramid of Menkaure. Gaze incredulously at the <u>Great Sphinx</u> of Giza, that eternal statue with the body of a lion and the face of a Pharaoh: it has guarded the pyramids for millennia. You'll also visit the Valley Temple in Giza, as it housed a lot of rituals and mummifications. Capture the spectacular views of this remarkable landscape to make it memorable for you.

Lunch would be at a quality local restaurant.

Grand Egyptian Museum:

Afterward, you would travel to the <u>Grand Egyptian Museum</u> tour (GEM), the biggest and most recently built museum, showcasing Egypt's ancient treasures. The impressive visit to the museum includes fantastic collections of statues, artifacts, and royal treasures from different dynasties. magnificent artifacts include many awesome pieces from the <u>Old Kingdoms</u>, <u>Middle Kingdoms</u>, and <u>New Kingdoms</u>, statues of mighty pharaohs, stunning jewelry, and some common objects that offer glimpses of ancient Egyptian life. Its ample space and proper design with detailed exhibitions make a wonderful journey through Egypt's long and diverse history.

Day 3

Day trip to Alexandria

After an early breakfast, you set off on a scenic drive to Alexandria, an eminent Mediterranean city in Egypt. Flush with history and a rich amalgam of influences from Egypt, Greece, and Rome, Alexandria is a must-see destination. Your 4-day Alexandria tour begins with a visit to the Catacombs of

Kom El Shoqafa:

Kom El Shoqafa, a 4th-century AD burial site that was made in an extraordinarily mixed Egyptian, Greek, and Roman style of culture. This ancient necropolis contains spiraling chambers with ornamental carvings and tombs, indicative of the historical diversity that was associated with Alexandria.

Then visit Pompey's Pillar in Alexandria, a soaring Roman column erected in the name of the Emperor Diocletian, and explore the nearby Serapeum ruins in Alexandria, a temple once dedicated to the god

Serapis.

Savor a delicious lunch at a quality local restaurant.

Continue to the Qaitbay Citadel:

Qaitbay Citadel tour, this magnificent fortress was built during the 15th century on the site of the Lighthouse of Alexandria, which was one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Not only is the citadel fermentatively well-preserved, but it also boasts a good sight of a brilliant blue Mediterranean, as well as sharing Alexandria's historical role of nexus for any maritime city. End your day with a visit

to the Bibliotheca Alexandrina:

a marvel of the present day, which drew its inspiration and ideals from the ancient <u>Library of Alexandria</u>. It is meant to be a cultural center, holding millions of books, exhibitions, and manuscripts as an icon of the legacy or history of Alexandria in learning and scholarship.

Return to the hotel in Cairo after the tour.

Overnight in Cairo.

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before being transferred to Cairo Airport, ensuring a timely arrival for your departure.
