This distinctive six-tiered pyramid represents a significant shift in ancient Egyptian building methods, much like the world's first large-scale stone structure. Enjoy the best day trips from Cairo to the Giza pyramids.

Memphis

Next, you will visit <u>Memphis</u>, the mythical first capital of Egypt, which was founded around 3100 BC by King Menes. The large limestone statue of Ramses II is, of course, located in the first-rate, fully outdoor museum. At the end of your Cairo day trip, your driver will then take you back to your hotel in comfort and safety.
