### Day 1

#### Pyramids, Museum & Bazaar Experience

They were built more than 4,500 years ago as tombs for kings and possess extraordinary precision and scale; with [the Great Pyramid](#), once called one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

#### The Great Sphinx:

With its singularly carved limestone structure, the magnificent statue bearing the body of a lion with the head of a pharaoh is the protector of the Giza Plateau, thought to be representing King Khafre. [The Great Sphinx](#) is one of the world's largest and oldest monumental sculptures, exhibiting strength, wisdom, and protection.

#### The Egyptian Museum:

Situated in Down Town Cairo, this museum is home to the largest collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts in the world. #### Khan El Khalili Bazaar:

this marketplace invites a sensory feast of colors, odors, and sounds. A centuries-old souk, [Khan El Khalili](#) Bazaar consists of slender alleys fringed by shops selling spices, perfumes, jewels, traditional crafts, textiles, and souvenirs.
