Overview

After lunch, visit the modern Library of Alexandria, an architectural masterpiece harboring millions of books and rare manuscripts, a must-visit cultural site for all literature lovers and history lovers. The trip would close, again, with a comfortable return to Alexandria Port, thus making the day's exploration as comfortable as possible.

Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa

The Catacombs of [Kom el Shoqafa](#) comprise an underground necropolis established in the 2nd century A.D. This splendid burial ground, displaying a rather unusual amalgamation of Egyptian, Greek, and Roman artistic styles, gives an interesting perspective into the multicultural heritage of Alexandria.

Pompey Pillar

Your first stop is the Pillar of Pompey, a red granite column soaring 25 m in height. A remarkable relic of the Roman period, the monument further attests to the fact that ancient Alexandria really did matter.

Qaitbay Citadel

Next, we will head to the [Citadel of Qaitbay](#), a 15th-century fortress built on the foundations of the fabled Lighthouse of Alexandria, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Stroll around the citadel to enjoy lovely views of the Mediterranean Sea while learning about its role in the defense of Alexandria.

Library of Alexandria

After lunch, your last stop will be the new Library of Alexandria. This architectural wonder is established in memory of the ancient Library of Alexandria and is truly worth visiting for every historian and literature lover. It is a world-class cultural complex holding millions of books, rare manuscripts, and state-of-the-art displays.

Upon completing your Alexandria tour, your driver will fetch you back to Alexandria Port in a cozy and safe manner.
